With our very own CCGS Aquatic Swim School now in full operation, we are inviting expressions of interest from our CGGS students to become casual Learn to Swim Teachers. In order to be eligible you will need to be aged at least 16.5 years prior to 30 December 2017.

### KEY SELECTION CRITERIA

To apply for one of these four roles, applicants must meet the following key selection criteria;

- Preferably an accredited AUSTSWIM Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety (if not, please see note\* below)
- Can demonstrate a passion for the sport and have a reasonable level of fitness and swimming ability
- Can demonstrate good communication and organisation skills

#### **Highly Desirable**

- Has represented CGGS at GSV level of competition and attended morning squad training sessions on a regular basis throughout their senior school / junior school years
- Has a history of competitive swimming in a Club Program

\* If you are not accredited by AUSTWIM you will need to undertake the AUSTSWIM "Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety Course". CGGS can assist in this process by providing the opportunity to attain the necessary pool-side training hours in our pool. Although individuals can enroll in an AUSTSWIM Teacher of Swimming and Water Safety course at 16 years of age, they are not eligible to receive full accreditation, which includes teaching in the pool, until they are 17 years of age.

It is CGGS objective to create a community based Swim School and support program, which encompasses the initiative to support our loyal, passionate and committed students whom have given their undivided support to swimming at CGGS throughout their senior school, and if applicable, junior school years.
