Camberwell Girls Grammar School offers a limited number of Means-Tested Scholarships to eligible families who are on a limited income. Means-Tested Scholarships are for entry at Years 7, 8, 9, 10 and 11. Scholarships are tenable as follows: Years 7 to 12; Years 8 to 12, Years 9 to 12; Years 10 to 12, Years 11 to 12.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- > Candidates must be Australian or New Zealand Citizens, or Permanent Residents in Australia. Candidates are required to provide a copy of their Australian or New Zealand Birth Certificate, or if born overseas, a copy of their Australian Citizenship Certificate, or Passport and Permanent Residency Visa.
- > Eligible Camberwell Girls Grammar School students may apply for the academic scholarship
- > Students are to be age and year level-appropriate
- > Photo ID is required on the day of the scholarship examination
- > Financial information must accompany the application (see below for further details)

STEP 1 / ONLINE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Contact the Admissions Manager to request a copy of the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form – email admissions@cggs.vic.edu.au. The Admissions Manager will email a copy of the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form to be completed and returned with supporting documentation.

STEP 4 / SEND DOCUMENTATION

1. Provide financial information by completing the Confidential Statement of Financial Circumstances Form along with a Covering Letter outlining the circumstances and reason for application for a Means-Tested Scholarship. Attach supporting documents including income tax returns and financial statements and email to the Finance Manager to financemanager@cggs.vic.edu.au Applications close Tuesday 9 February 2021, 5.00pm.

2. Email the following documents to the Admissions Manager at admissions@cogs.vic.edu.au with the email subject line: Means- Tested Scholarship – CANDIDATE NAME

- > Birth Certificate
- > Australian Citizenship Certificate, or Passport and Permanent Resident Visa (if born overseas)
- > Latest school report
- > NAPLAN report

Submitting Documentation

To be considered for a Means-Tested Scholarship, you must send the documentation outlined above (Step 4) by post, or email to financemanager@cogs.vic.edu.au by Tuesday 9 February 2021, 5.00 pm. You are not required to submit supporting documents using the online Academic Scholarship Form.

Testing Day Information

Once you have registered online, you will receive further information from Edutest via email in the week leading up to the scholarship exam including what to bring on the day. This is generally sent the Monday or Tuesday prior to testing day.

Results

Shortlisted candidates will be contacted by the school for an interview with the Principal / Head of School, generally 2 to 3 weeks after the testing. A comprehensive Edutest scholarship report will be posted to unsuccessful candidates at the end of Term 1 or beginning of Term 2, 2021 once the scholarship process is completed.

Scholarship Terms & Conditions

Means-Tested Scholarships apply to tuition fees and do not cover composite fees, private music lessons, activities such as specialist camps and exchanges, school uniform, textbooks / resources or IT requirements all of which are the responsibility of parents.

- > Scholarship holders are expected to complete their education at CGGS and maintain a high standard of academic achievement, participate in the life of the school and be a positive member of the school community. The performance of each student is reviewed annually. In the event of a student's withdrawal prior to completing their education, the full value of the Scholarship up to that time will be repayable to the school.
- > No Scholarship holder may hold more than one Scholarship.
- > A sibling discount does not apply to a Scholarship holder.

Value of Scholarships

Scholarships are awarded at the Principal's discretion. The number of scholarships offered and the percentage of tuition fee remission will vary according to the calibre of the candidates.
